Minutes of Quechee Library Trustees' Meeting Oct. 9, 2023

Library Director's Report: Kate Schaal presented her written report. The report was unanimously accepted (moved by Dave, seconded by Bill), with a discussion of a number of issues:

- 1. Michaela is quickly becoming an excellent new assistant and is developing new initia tives with George.
- 2. The construction on Main Street has made it difficult for many people to access the library; despite this circulation was up in Quechee by 3% compared to last year.
- 3. We have several upcoming programs, including tomorrow's at 5 pm with Rick Winston, author of *Red Scare in the Green Mountains: The McCarthy Era in Vermont 1946-1960*. On Sunday, Oct. 15, Alex Prud'homme will talk about his book, *Dinner with the President: Food, Politics, and a History of Breaking Bread at the White House*. There will be an appetizer table featuring favorite foods and a concurrent children's program. This should be a fun and interesting event.
- 4. George and Michaela are planning a Halloween celebration at Wilder for Friday, Oct. 27, 3-6pm.
- 5. Our presentation to the select board will be on Tuesday, Oct. 17 at 6pm. We will include our budget request, as part of our discussion of how we serve the town.
